Crimewave Security Cameras >>>


In our last newsletter we announced the start of a contract with Crimewave Security Consultancy, a mobile CCTV solution.

We are pleased to announce that this has now commenced, and the first area we installed the camera was in Oakgrove, overlooking the shopping plaza, and initial reports from Thames Valley Police (TVP) tells us there had been a reduction in antisocial behaviour in that area.

Crimewave continue to liaise on our behalf with other agencies such as TVP and Milton Keynes Councils Environmental Crime Unit to look at potential future camera sites across the parish to continue to target hotspots in our area.

We would like to take this opportunity to introduce you to Community Trees MK – A fantastic initiative to plant more trees in MK!

We are Community Trees Milton Keynes and we have a very simple initial mission – to enable communities to plant at least 1000 trees each year for ten years.

2020 turned out not to be the best year to start. The global pandemic made community involvement in tree planting a real challenge and our community tree-planting days had to be postponed and then cancelled. So, we had to be imaginative to get our trees in the ground amid Covid-19 restrictions.

Newport Pagnell Town Council provided oak trees to local people to plant around the town; MK Youth Cabinet planted a hedge and fruit trees in Coffee Hall. And The Parks Trust planted up the verge alongside Brickhill Street at Oakgrove and brought forward their plans for Middleton Wood Meadow. In the end we beat our target and got 1,700 trees planted, we have a tree nursery on an allotment plot loaned to us by BROUGHTON & Milton Keynes Parish Council and, we are working with The Parks Trust Outdoor Learning Team to help schools plant trees.

But now we want **your** help with our exciting plans and new weekend community tree planting events for the coming winter season (you can only plant trees when they are dormant). We have trees provided by the Woodland Trust, The International Tree Foundation and The Parks Trust, and we are ready to plant!

Locally, there will be community planting days with the Parish Council and The Parks Trust to extend the new woodland in Middleton Wood Meadow near MK Village. If you are interested to join in, save the date – 19th and 20th February 2022 – and get your warm clothes ready!

As the main growing season comes to an end, it's getting much quieter down on our four allotment sites. Work is progressing on the new Brooklands site and we are still on target to be taking the site on in late 2022.

We will be reopening the waiting lists for our current sites in January 2022 – Brooklands will remain closed.

Now bird nesting season has finished, our Landscapers have been busy, getting those essential shrub and tree maintenance jobs done around the parish. They have undertaken some clearance work at our Walton Road Allotment site, to remove historical rubbish left by past tenants and cleared the boundary so we are able to maintain our fences and hedges easily.
