# What is a Parish Council? >>>

A parish council is a local authority that makes decisions on behalf of the people in the parish. It is the level of government closest to the community, with the district authority (Milton Keynes Council) above it in the hierarchy. As it is the authority closest to the people, parish councils are usually the first place people will go with concerns or ideas. For this reason, they are a vital part of any community.

#### Devolution >>>

#### What is devolution?

"Devolution – the transfer or delegation of power to a lower level.

### Why is it happening?

Central government cuts have forced Local Authorities to look at how they manage services and assets. These Local Authorities, such as Milton Keynes Council, whose tax-raising powers are capped – are delivering less services and maintaining less local assets than they formerly did. They are looking towards Local and Parish Councils to take over many of these responsibilities.

### What are the opportunities for this Parish Council?

- Devolution could enable the parish council to have more control over the services currently delivered centrally from Milton Keynes Council.
- It could allow us to work with and listen to residents to ensure the right services are delivered in the right way.
- It could provide greater freedom and flexibilities at a local level, meaning the parish council can work more effectively to improve public services for their area.

### What are the challenges for this Parish Council?

- Devolution is one thing for Town Councils like Newport Pagnell which already have a larger staff base and significant precepting income – but quite another for smaller Parish councils like ourselves with just two office staff and a part-time contracted Warden.
- For Parish Councils like ourselves, wanting to see important local services and/or much valued local buildings, parks and open spaces preserved, it could require a massive step up – in aspirations, staff capacity, precepts and volunteer time.
- Added to which, we are required to meet the same legal requirements on a range of issues from transparency to data protection that much larger councils are required to meet.

## How will we keep residents up to date?

- Parish Council Meetings, held on the first Monday of the month, apart from Aug when we don't hold a meeting.
- Website We will publish up to date information on a dedicated area of our website.


