Ideally, to ensure that we have a diverse range of councillors, we are looking for more female councillors. Training for new councillors is available to help assist with understanding the responsibilities of the role.

Hummingbirds Children Centre Coming to Oakgrove!



Earlier in September we started partnership with Hummingbirds Children's Centre to provide an outreach Song and Story time and a Baby session in Oakgrove.

These happen every Monday morning during term time from our Oakgrove meeting room at 27 Atlas Way, MK10 9SG. Please enter building via the side entrance by the red post box.

The Song and Story Time starts at 9:30am, so come along for a story, followed by interactive songs and rhymes. Suitable for pre-school children. The session finishes at 10:15am.

From 10:45am until 11:30am there will be a baby session. The baby group is for non-walkers, an opportunity to experience a wide range of age-appropriate activities, including sensory activities, this helps parent and baby, to support learning, development, and bonding.

They are based in Shackerstone Close, Broughton MK10 9LS – right next to Broughton Fields School. Following on from the OPEN LETTER (04/08/21) sent by the Parish Council to Crest Nicholson, and all parties involved in this long-standing issue over the past 8-years.

We received a letter from Milton Keynes Council (MKC) on 07/09/21 confirming that, having had no meaningful response with the developer, they had issued a planning enforcement letter to Crest Nicholson on 01/09/21, giving them 21 days to respond. MKC has confirmed that should they not receive any response; they will have no alternative than to take formal action.

Could your spare room be a safe place to sleep?

Depaul UK is looking for volunteer hosts in Broughton and Milton Keynes Parish to help change the lives of young people at risk of homelessness.

Nightstop Milton Keynes aims to provide a safe place to sleep for vulnerable young people aged 16-25 in an innovative, community focused initiative: placing the guests in homes of trained and vetted volunteer hosts.

Offering their spare room one night at a time, Nightstop is a safer and more welcoming alternative than traditional emergency accommodation.

Already successfully running around the country, the national youth homelessness prevention charity Depaul UK has been commissioned by the Milton Keynes Council to launch Nightstop later this year. However, as the service relies on an army of volunteers, the team need your help!

Could you offer young people a bed for the night, a hot meal, a wash, and a listening ear?

At Nightstop, the safety and wellbeing of guests and hosts is of the upmost importance, with extensive support provided. Plus, volunteers can commit to as much or as little time as they are able – **just one night makes a difference.**

The main reason for homeless in young people is because of relationship breakdown at home. This is why Depaul MK also runs its Reconnect service, supporting young people and their families to overcome conflict.
